The 2009 vintage Marilyn Merlot is the Silver Anniversary (25th) release of this venerable wine. It is a blend of 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon from grapes grown and vinified in the Napa Valley. Complex and complementary aromas of dried herbs, toasty oak, and mature varietal fruit are a testimony to the legacy of this iconic label. Moderate alcohol, classic varietal fruit and good acidity makes this wine a winning partner with fine foods of many cultures. Vineyard locations for this wine are from longtime growers in the Yountville and Oakville regions of the Napa Valley.
